- Thoughts on a solution for the rodeos who don't pay a lot and don't give much money and don't want to give prizes, the extra money will be put towards a prize for the winning team made a motion for it to be thought of further park it for a year Justin seconds

### Old Business:

- Entry System John suggested split chutes half are based on top standings and half are based on call times
  - Ryan Murray suggested to leave 1-2 chutes open for locals
- Point System Based on points Encourages people to enter smaller rodeos
- Unanimous point system teams entered all the way down ex. 8-1 from first to last for those who cross. Payouts are only for teams 1-4 who cross
  - Before Call Ins
- First priority goes to paid members
- Second priority goes to standings the first rodeo of the year will go off the standings from the previous year if the team is entering under the same name.
- Third Priority goes to how many rodeos you have been to
- Last Priority goes to local entries 80km-100km
- All remaining entries will be added onto first serve basis

Ryder makes a motion to use the US entry rules as our new entry system and have the local entries as a 150km radius. Jason seconds - Unanimous

- Cross enter to fill chutes
